



## ***ANNIKA KLEIST***

Annika Kleist, born in 1986 in Hagenow, Germany, studied Painting at the Academy of Fine Arts in Leipzig. In 2012, the artist received an Erasmus scholarship from the Camberwell College of Arts, London. Kleist obtained her diploma in 2014, and continued a master class with Prof. Astrid Klein until 2017. She currently lives and works in Berlin.

Annika Kleist has had multiple exhibitions in Germany and the UK. In 2017, she received the prize of the Leipziger Jahresausstellung.

In such manner, they allow the viewer to halt time and observe the material that constitutes the bulk of the day-to-day experience, to reveal the sensations that impact an individual on a subconscious level.*



## ***TOBIAS LEHNER***

Tobias Lehner was born in 1974 in Regensburg, Germany. He received his diploma of Painting in 2003 and finished his Masters studies in 2005, both at the Academy of Visual Arts Leipzig with Prof. Sighard Gille. He still lives and works in Leipzig.

Lehner's solo exhibitions have taken place in Germany as well as internationally such as in London, Paris, Amsterdam, Houston, Texas and Seoul. In the same vein, his paintings have been exhibited in Palacio de Sibeles, Madrid, Salsali Private Museum Dubai, Essl Museum Vienna, Arario Gallery in Beijing, Marianne Boesky Gallery in New York and many others.



## ***GEORG WEISSBACH***

Georg Weißbach was born in 1987 in Leipzig. From 2008 to 2015, he studied Visual Arts at the Academy of Fine Arts in Leipzig. There, he also acquired his master's qualification in 2017 with Prof. Astrid Klein.


In 2013, together with Paul Bowler, Weißbach founded the artist duo ART N MORE, which had numerous exhibitions such as at Kunsthalle Mannheim, Kreuzberg Pavillon Berlin and the Museum of Visual Arts Leipzig.

Weißbach's solo work has been shown in several shows in galleries and institutions in Germany as well as in the UK and Iceland.
